### Clarity4D's profiles supported a triple-sponsored programme designed to help young women transition from study to work.

Project Headway was an aspirational programme, led by the London Metropolitan Police and two of the city's top legal firms, designed to help teenage girls realise their potential and understand the connection between their school studies and the workplace.

This project focused very much on personal development and practical measures that a young person can take to maximise their opportunities and competitive advantage, including mentoring, character profiling, revision and self-development sessions.
